## ECONOMICS

*Sample Course Offering for Fall and Spring semester:*

**Economic Development (ECON-361)** surveys major issues related to the economics of developing countries in Latin America, Africa, and Asia. The course examines the meaning and measurement of economic development, theories of development and underdevelopment, and policies to alleviate poverty and promote development in the low-and middle-income countries of the world.

**Money, Banking, and Finance in the Global Economy (ECON-332)** introduces students to the economics of money, banking, and capital markets in a globalizing world. Issues examined include central banking, monetary integration, currency competition, dollarization, electronic money. Students will consider banking problems and policies in emerging market economies as well as developed markets economies, and discuss appropriate policies for regulating global financial institutions. Prerequisite: ECON-100.

**Chinese Economy (SOOE-3001)** covers a wide range of topics in Chinese economic life as well as its historical background. It provides students an overall view of the Chinese economy and particularly its important performance and function in the contemporary global system.
