The Campus Ambassador Position: Each year, G-MEO hires enthusiastic G-MEO program alumni and non-alumni to work as our "campus ambassadors." Campus Ambassadors (CA's) are current students at a G-MEO partner school who assist G-MEO in our efforts to reach out to, engage with, and eventually enroll, qualified students into our programs. As a campus ambassador, you will play a key role that is one part recruiter and one part brand ambassador, while working closely with your school's G-MEO Account Executive (AE) to achieve target recruitment goals.

Attributes of a Great CA: The Campus Ambassador position is a great fit for G-MEO program alumni, as well as other students interested in international education, study abroad, business, sales, marketing, communications or related fields. The requirements of the position best align with students who are:

- Outgoing, confident, and comfortable with public speaking since you'll be interacting frequently with faculty and students.
- Organized and reliable, since we expect you to perform many tasks unsupervised and be responsive to your AE's directions.
- Flexible, because being a campus ambassador does entail devoting time during the day or evening to help with recruitment events or recruitment follow up.
- Enthusiastic about your experiences studying abroad in China with G-MEO, or studying abroad in another program.

Position Requirements:

- Must be a current college or University student in good academic standing.
- Must be available to devote up to 6 hours/week to Campus Ambassador work.
- Must have reliable internet and/or cell-phone service.
