

Ming Chuan University

Ming Chuan University (MCU) is a well-known, internationally focused university located in Taiwan. It was the first university in Taiwan to offer courses completely taught in English, and the first university in Asia to be accredited by the Middle States Commission of Higher Education, U.S.A.. As one of Taiwan's most respected institutions, it was listed in the Top 10 "Preferred universities" among major international corporations in Taiwan. MCU offers an international and multicultural campus environment and a bilingual (English/Mandarin) learning and living environment. With more than 150 partner universities globally, it has more than 2,000 international students coming from countries all over the world.

Fields of Study: All programs are offered completely in English through MCU's International College. One semester or academic year in the following programs: International Business and Trade, Journalism and Mass Communication, Fashion and Innovation Management (Taipei campus); Travel and Tourism, International Affairs and Diplomacy, Applied Computing (Taoyuan campus).

Accommodation: MCU will provide students with off-campus accommodation. Single occupancy (a dormitory room for one student) is the default option. Double occupancy (a dormitory room shared by two students) is based on availability. Both options include a toilet and shower in each room.

Program Fee: \$10,200 per semester including single occupancy accommodation, tuition, international insurance, and cultural excursions. **\$9,200** per semester for double occupancy accommodation, tuition, international insurance, and cultural excursions. Additional expenses may include airfare, meals, and other activities.

Application Deadline: November 30 for Spring semester; April 15 for Fall semester.

Excursions: Near our Taipei and Taoyuan campuses, you can visit the National Palace Museum, home to perhaps the finest collection of Chinese art in the world. You can see atmospheric old streets and temples in towns like Lugang and Tainan. Opportunities for outdoor activities include visits to Taroko National Park, a narrow ravine created by a river which has cut through the mountains, Yu Mountain National Park, which has the highest peak in Northeast Asia, Yangming Mountain National Park, with volcanic craters and lakes, Kending National Park, Taiwan's tropical area, and Dongsha Marine National Park, with white coral and shell beaches.

Academics: During the semester, each student can take up to 25 school credit hours maximum. Final course selection is completed upon arrival to campus, and each student can select their own courses. Chinese language credits are optional.
