

Our Founder

Dr.David Chang

Dr. David C. Chang was named the ninth President of Polytechnic University, now known as Polytechnic Institute of NYU on July 1, 1994, and was appointed Chancellor in July 2005. In addition to being a full professor at his home institution, Dr. Chang also holds honorary professorships at five major universities in China.

Dr. Chang holds a Master's and Ph.D. in applied physics from Harvard University and a Bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from National Cheng-Kung University in Taiwan. He was elected a Fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) in 1985, is a past President of the IEEE Antennas and Propagation Society, and Chairman of the U.S. National Committee of the International Scientific Radio Union. Dr. Chang has a distinguished record of academic achievements in electromagnetic theory, antennas analysis, microwave & optical integrated circuit. He was awarded the IEEE Third Millennium Medal in 2000.

Apart from his academic activities, Dr. Chang has actively involved in a number of civic and not-for-profit organizations including serving on the Commission on Independent Colleges & Universities (CICU), a member of Mayor Michael Bloomberg's Transition Team and Mayor's Committee on Appointments. He was appointed by Mayor Bloomberg to serve on the Panel for Educational Policies, which is the governing board for New York City's school system, and has served in 2009-10 as its chairman. Dr. Chang is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations; was on the National Advisory Council for the Bill & Melinda Gates Millennium Scholars, 2001-2010, and is a member of The Committee of 100, a Chinese American organization dedicated to better Sino-American relations and is currently serving as a cochair for its international programs. He co-founded in 2011 G-MEO and has been serving as its Chairman of the Board of Directors and Chief Executive

Who Can Apply?

G-MEO's programs are open to a wide variety of students during semester, summer, and a full year. Our participants may include current students matriculated at US universities who wish to earn their American credits in China, students who are aiming to earn American credits before pursuing education in a US university, and high school students in good academic standing who want to get ahead. All programs offer a chance for Chinese and American students to interact and study together.

All students must be in good academic standing in order to participate in G-MEO's programs. Students are suggested to discuss in detail their intent to join the program of their choice with their home institution, and obtain the approval of their academic advisor prior to submitting their application.

Chengdu has a population of over 16 million and is a booming economic center. China's "Go West" policy aims to develop Chengdu into a financial and cultural center on par with Beijing and Shanghai. It abounds with urban energy and entrepreneurial dynamism; its new subway system opened in 2010. Yet with a balmy, sub-tropical climate and a slower pace than Beijing or Shanghai, Chengdu is known for its quality of life. It is famous for its world-class cuisine, leisurely tea houses, local opera and historic temples.

It is also easy to escape Chengdu to hike or cycle through timeless rural villages, Buddhist and Taoist temples and monasteries, and mountain preserves. For those interested in wildlife and biodiversity, Chengdu is close to the Giant Panda Research Center and the Wolong Nature Reserve. There are recently excavated archaeological sites, such as Sanxingdui which rivals the Terracotta Warriors of Xi'an, with breathtaking bronze objects over 4,900 years old. These cultural elements will also form part of your studies.

The Study Away American Credit Program ("Study Away Program") has been developed by G-MEO to accommodate Chinese international students who are located in China but enrolled in US universities. The Study Away Program puts Chinese international students in an English language, US-style learning environment in China while also keeping their American education on track. Those who are not yet enrolled in a US university but plan to in the future may also participate in order to earn credits and get ahead. Students will not only have access to convenient and high-quality academics, but also have the chance to participate in part-time internship and on-site extracurricular activities. This program also provides US universities with a suitable site in China to host their incoming Chinese international freshmen, and to launch their overseas semester program.

The Study Away American Credit Program was developed with one of the top US-accredited universities in New Jersey, Fairleigh Dickinson University (FDU). Upon completion of the study away program, FDU issues each student an official transcript with 100% credit transferability, assuring that all students can stick with their study plans. Students can look forward to taking advantage of FDU's valuable contributions to this program.

Who Should Attend?

If students are unable or choose not to come (back) to the US for any reason, they are welcome to join us for the Study Away Program. They can fulfill their academic goals and enjoy a colorful university life in the beautiful city of Chengdu!



G-MEO Internship Programs

Students accepted to study at the Chengdu American Center are eligible to apply to one or more of the unique internships available. Weekly time commitment and duration of internships can vary. They can be part-time or full- time, depending on the particular internship and program. Students might work at the Chengdu High Tech Zone in one of many new industrial and tech areas such as IT/computer science, engineering, consulting or biomedical engineering and pharmaceuticals. Students interested in education or research can work at schools in Chengdu or work closely with a research fellow at the Sichuan Academy of Social Sciences on projects that range across economic development, migrant education, earthquake reconstruction, and tourism development. Students with specific areas of interest that are not listed can also place a request to help find an internship. All students must complete an internship application online.

On-site Internship

Summer Credit-Bearing Internship Program (SCBI)

This program is a summer internship and experiential learning program that caters to students who are seeking a career building summer opportunity abroad. This 10-week full-time internship allows students to gain additional professional skills and knowledge through taking Business Mandarin Chinese and enrolling in our Professional Development and Experiential Learning course. Upon completion of the program, students will receive the Chengdu City Award worth about \$1,450 (RMB10,000) and other scholarships.

Semester Part-Time Internship

Depending on your course schedule, students can also intern part-time while studying for a semester with G-MEO. Internship placement, Professional Development, and Internship courses are included in your tuition!

3+3 Study-Intern Abroad Program (Spring + Summer OR Summer + Fall)

This unique program allows students to do a part-time internship and take 3 months of course work including Business Mandarin Chinese during the Spring or Fall Semester. Students also enroll in our Professional Development and Internship course over the entire period of the program. Following the Spring semester or prior to Fall semester students will complete a 3-month intensive full-time internship in Chengdu during the summer. Upon completion of the program, students will be eligible for the Chengdu City Award worth about \$3,600 (RMB 25,000) and other scholarships.

International Internship Certificate Program (IIC)

The IIC program is a non-credit internship program designed for co-op and graduate students to enhance their professional and global skills. Students can live abroad and intern full-time for a semester (14 weeks) or summer (10 weeks). The program includes 3 seminars: Professional Development & Internship, How to do Business in China and Basic Chinese for Business Purposes. Upon completion of the program, students will receive a certificate along with the Chengdu City Award worth up to \$2,200 (RMB 15,000) and other scholarships.

Students who are admitted to the Chengdu American Center program each Fall and Spring semester are eligible to be considered for this assistantship to help with their living expenses while studying abroad. The amount of the scholarship ranges from RMB 6,000 - RMB 12,000 (approx. \$850 - 1,700) and is awarded in monthly installments. Selection of the assistantship recipients will be based on merit and financial need.

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Submit a 500-word essay detailing why you are interested in studying abroad and how you expect the experience to support your future goals.
- Provide a copy of Financial Aid Award Letter issued by your home university.

G-MEO TRAVEL GRANT

Fall / Spring / 3+3

Students who are admitted to the Chengdu American Center semester program are eligible to be considered for the \$500 Travel Grant to assist with their trip to Chengdu, China. Selection of the award will be based on merit and financial need.

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Submit a 500-word essay detailing why you are interested in studying abroad and how you expect the experience to support your future goals.
- Provide a copy of Financial Aid Award Letter issued by your home university.

G-MEO MATCHING SCHOLARSHIP

Fall/Spring/3+3

If you get any internal scholarships awarded by your institution which are transferable to study abroad for G-MEO's Chengdu American Center semester program, G- MEO will match up to \$1,500. For example, if you receive a \$1,000 internal university scholarship for study abroad, G-MEO will match another \$1,000.

G-MEO MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP

- Fall/Spring Semester: RMB 15,000 (approx. \$2,200)
- 3+3 Study-Intern Program: RMB 25,000 (approx. \$3,600)
- Summer Session Program: RMB 5,000 (approx. \$730)
- Summer Internship: RMB 10,000 (approx. \$1,450)
- IIC Program: RMB 15,000 (approx. \$2,200)
- 1 Program, Two Cities: RMB 5,000 (approx. \$730)

This award is provided by the Mayor's Office of the Municipal Government of Chengdu and disbursed in RMB upon successful completion of the program in Chengdu.



1. Do I need to know any Chinese to study abroad in China?

No. Academic courses are all taught in English, and local staff working with international students speak English. But we highly recommend taking a Chinese course while you are there.

2. Can I do an internship?

Yes. There are year-round options in Chengdu to participate in a global internship, for credit or non-credit. During the summer, there are full-time opportunities through the credit-bearing Summer Internship Program and the non-credit International Internship Certificate Program (IIC). Semester students may elect to do a part-time internship for credit or not for credit as one of their selected courses. There is also a full-time, non-credit option during the Spring /Fall or summer through the International Internship Certificate Program (IIC).

3. What GPA is required to attend a program?

GPA requirements are set by your home institution. You must meet these requirements to be able to study abroad.

4. Can my financial aid package be used to cover the costs of studying abroad?

Your home institution is responsible for approval procedures of your financial aid. Most students are able to use their federal financial aid while studying abroad, as long as the credits they earn are approved by their home institution. Please contact your financial aid office for more details.

5. Do I need a passport?

Yes. Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the last date of your program. If you need to renew or obtain a passport for the first time, please start this process immediately. It can take up to a few weeks and you cannot apply for a visa without a passport after you have been admitted to a program.

6. How do I apply for a Chinese student visa?

The New York Student Affairs Office will instruct you on how to obtain a Chinese visa. Detailed information will be included in your pre-departure package.

7. Is Chengdu a safe place?

Chengdu is a very safe and relaxed city. However, there is a lot of movement and bicycle traffic that you must be aware of. Please try to stay in groups. Also, always be aware of your surroundings and your personal belongings. You'll learn more about local tips during an onsite orientation.

8. Where will I live during the program?

Housing options differ depending on your program. For Chengdu programs, all housing is situated near or on Sichuan University's Huaxi campus in downtown Chengdu, within walking distance to the Chengdu American Center where all your classes will be held. During the semester, you'll stay in the International Students Overseas dorm. Summer programs have hotel options. For the Shanghai summer program, all students will live in hotels near the Shanghai Center. Please refer to your specific program's information page for more information.

9. Can I transfer courses I take with G-MEO to get credit from my home university?

Yes, based on the approval of your home university. To transfer credit, you will need to obtain pre-approval BEFORE GOING ABROAD from your school. Different schools have different policies, so you must check with your academic advisor or study abroad office first.

10. How do I complete the application?

To apply for a G-MEO program, you must create an account and complete the application on our website, www.gmeochina.com. In order to successfully secure your spot in the program or an Early Bird discount, you'll need to pay the application fee and the non-refundable deposit by the deadline. Login or contact your G-MEO representative to check on your application status.
