Norwich University's School of Nursing helps meet a critical demand for nurses with vision, innovation, and educational excellence. Norwich University (in short: NU) and Global Maximum Educational Opportunities (in short: G-MEO) would like to collaborate to develop a Global Health/Nursing Program at G-MEO's Chengdu American Center for Study Abroad, starting in 2019 Fall, to prepare students to be globally minded nurse leaders and scholars through innovative and diverse experiential education abroad experience.

The Chengdu American Center for Study Abroad provides a Western-style learning environment with courses taught in English and offered by a consortium of American universities, including Norwich University. The Center is located on the Sichuan University's beautiful Huaxi campus in central district of Chengdu, the capital of Sichuan Province in China's southwest. The Center is operated by G-MEO (www.gmeochina.com) since Spring 2013. There are 480+ college students studied or interned at the Center since then.

- Semester:** Fall 2019 (From end of August to early of December 2019)
- Curriculum:** Three NU's Nursing courses, taught by NU's own faculty member:
- NR 225: Research for Evidence-Based Practice
 - NR 206: Health Assessment Across the Lifespan
 - NR 232: Technology and Informatics in Healthcare
- Other courses associate with this program
- PY 220: Development Psychology
 - Modern Chinese Culture and Society
 - Math
 - A dozen courses in Business, International Study, Criminal Justice, China Study, etc.
- School of Record:** Sichuan University (SCU). The courses will be co-listed and SCU will issue transcripts to the enrolled students who complete the program.
- Award:** Chengdu City Government Achievement Award: RMB 15,000 (~\$2000)
